



PRC 200-Level Course Overview

PRC 201: Situational Awareness (SA): Discover how developing good self awareness is the first key to maintaining great situational awareness. Build habit patterns to enhance your airborne SA and avoid errors. Understand the impact of your perceptions and intuition and implement tools to improve them. Learn how to apply the five step process for maintaining SA during changing scenarios in-flight.

PRC 202: Instructing and Evaluating Professional Airmanship: Learn the keys to flight instruction and evaluation based on a holistic set of airmanship skills. This module is based on the award winning books, Redefining Airmanship and Flight Discipline, and through it you will develop briefing skills to support student learning as well as learn to utilize the in flight toolkit and checklists to track and debrief student performance. Become a master instructor of big picture airmanship.

PRC 203: Aviation Staff Officer and Safety Program Management: The roll out of Safety Management System (SMS) requirements mandate full integration of operations and staff. This module provides keys to risk control at levels not always addressed in traditional safety programs. The course is designed for Safety Officers and other key safety staff.

PRC 204: Leadership Course: This short course is designed for Senior Management who oversee aviation programs as well as Directors of Flight Operations, Chief Pilots, Maintenance Supervisors and other supervisory personnel.
